





TORQUE CHART

Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.


▲ CAUTION

 To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.

NOTE:


- Heat the bonding surfaces with a hair dryer if the ambient air temperature is below 70°F (21°C).
- The adhesive reaches full strength in 72 hours. Wait at least 24 hours before riding your motorcycle.
- Disconnect the negative (-) cable from the battery before installing this accessory.
- The clock memory will be erased when you disconnect the battery. Reset the memories after reconnecting the battery.
- Reinstall the removed parts on the motorcycle and make sure that the wires and harnesses are not pinched.
- 1. Perform step 1 to 18 on the trunk sub harness (sold separately) installation instructions.
- 2. Remove the clip as shown.




- 3. Remove the hinge rubber as shown.
 - · Repeat on the left side.




4. Remove the right trunk hinge as shown.



5. Remove the right hinge as shown.




6. Remove the damper as shown.




7. Remove the left trunk hinge, left hinge and damper in the same manner as the right side.


8. Remove the clip as shown.




9. Install the accessory damper as shown.




10. Install the right hinge as shown.




- 11. Install the accessory damper and left hinge in the same manner as the right side.

 - · Remove any burrs from the edge of the hole.




- 15. Drill 19 mm holes at the marked points of the trunk lid as shown.
 - Remove any burrs from the edge of the hole.





- 16. Drill a 10 mm hole the marked point of the trunk lid as shown.
 - Remove any burrs from the edge of the hole.






17. Install the grommets as shown.







18. Attach the label as shown.




19. Place the rubber washers as shown.




20. Install the lower plate and upper plate as shown.




21. Install the collars as shown.




22. Clean the surface of the area shown using isopropyl alcohol.




- 23. Attach the masking tape as shown.
 - Repeat on the right side.







24. Install the spring nuts as shown.



29. Clean the surface of the area shown using isopropyl alcohol.





30. Attach the cushion tape as shown.




31. Perform step 19 to 22 on the trunk sub harness (sold separately) installation instructions.

 - Confirm that any wire harness is not caught or too tight.







33. Store the terminal in the harness boot as shown.




34. Install the striker rods as shown.




35. Apply dish soap solution to the position shown.




36. Install the trunk rack as shown.
