CENTERSTAND



WIND DEFLECTOR



- The maximum power rating of connected accessories is 36W (12V, 3A).
- Use accessories with engine running to avoid discharging the battery.
- Do not use a cigarette lighter, as this can cause a malfunction.
- Cover the socket with the cap when the accessory socket is not used to prevent entry of foreign objects.
- Carefully secure any connected devices, as vibrations may cause them to shift unexpectedly.
- Make sure that the cable of device connected to the accessory socket does not disturb the steering operation or riding. Do not pinch the cable to prevent from being damaged.

Before starting your motorcycle, check that the side stand and the centerstand are fully retracted.

Always choose a flat ground when setting the centerstand.

1. Park safely on a level ground and stop the engine.

• Let down the centerstand, stand on the left side of the motorcycle. Hold the left handle grip and the left grab rail or rear carrier. Press down on the tip of the stand with your right foot and, simultaneously, pull up and back.

HEATED GRIPS



• Do not attempt to move the motorcycle with holding front light bar and also to apply extra pressure on them. It may damage the motorcycle and light bar.

6.6 lb (3.0 kg)

- Before riding, close the rear seat bag.
- The rear seat bag is not perfectly watertight, and water may enter when it rains, etc.
- Do not store valuables or fragile articles in the rear seat bag.
- To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing and removing the accessory.
- When washing the motorcycle and when leaving the motorcycle, remove the rear seat bag.
- Do not let anybody ride on the rear seat bag and do not place luggage onto it.
- Never use organic solvents such as gasoline, thinner and benzine to clean this accessory. Also do not use acid or alkaline cleaners to clean this accessory.

Wipe up spilled brake or battery fluid at once as they may damage the surface.





- 2. Tighten the straps while adjusting the balance between the right and left sides of the rear seat bag as shown.
 - Repeat on the right side.
 - Secure well by pulling the straps tight.

HOW TO USE THE EXTENDED REAR SEAT BAG

1. Open the fastener as shown.

2. Pull up the rear seat bag as shown.



REAR TRUNK

- Before riding, confirm that lid is closed.

Firmly pull to secure the belts.

3. Rising the upper part of hinge, move the hinge down as shown and open the lid.

5. Remove the key.

• Make sure the lid is locked down securely.



HOW TO CLOSE THE REAR TRUNK

1. Confirm that the key position is as shown.



2. Close the lid.



- 3. Holding the upper part of the hinge, push the hinge down.
- 4. Lock the rear trunk by turning the key in the direction shown.
 - Be careful not to have the stored item pinched when the rear trunk is closed.



HOW TO STORE THE REAR TRUNK **INNER BAG**

- **1.** Open the rear trunk and store the rear trunk inner bag.
- 2. Close the rear trunk.
- · Be careful not to have the stored item pinched when the rear trunk is closed.





- The weight of the cargo must not exceed the following maximum weight capacity:
 Each pannier 8.8 lb (4.0 kg)
- Load weight equally on both sides to minimize imbalance. If the weight is not loaded equally on both sides or if it exceeds the maximum weight capacity of this accessory, handling is proportionally affected, resulting in serious accident or injury.
- Do not store valuables or fragile articles in the panniers.
- Be sure that the panniers are installed securely before riding.
- Before riding, confirm that lid is closed.
- To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing and removing the accessory.
- The pannier is hot while the engine is running and after it has been stopped (after riding etc.).
 Especially the lower part of the pannier on the right side is close to the muffler and thus becomes very hot, for that reason it should not be touched for some time.
- The panniers are not perfectly watertight, and water may enter when washing the motorcycle, when it rains, etc.
- Always install panniers on both the left and the right side.
- Don't place a heavy object on the opened lid or apply an excessive force from the top of opened lid.
- Open and close the lid gently.
- If the pannier gets dirty, slightly push and clean it with a sponge or a shop towel moistened with a neutral detergent, remove the detergent with clean water, and then wipe them dry with a clean sponge or shop towel.
- Never use organic solvents such as gasoline, thinner and benzine to clean this accessory. Also do not use acid or alkaline cleaners to clean this accessory.

- 5. Remove the key. Be sure that the handle lever cannot be released and the left pannier is installed securely.
 - The pannier can come off during riding unless it is mounted securely.

HOW TO REMOVE THE PANNIERS

1. Remove the panniers in the reverse order of installation.

3. Open the lid.

HOW TO CLOSE THE PANNIERS

 Close the panniers in reverse order of opening.
 Be careful not to have the stored item pinched when the rear trunk is closed.



HOW TO OPEN THE PANNIERS

1. Install the key. Release the lock by turning the key clockwise.





HOW TO INSTALL THE LUGGAGE BAND

1. Open the lid.

- 2. Install the luggage band as shown.
- Secure the hooks to the shaded parts.



TANK BAG

• The weight of the cargo must not exceed the following maximum weight capacity:

for USA

3.3 lb (1.5 kg)

- Be sure that the tank bag is installed securely before riding.
- Before riding, close the tank bag.
- The tank bag is not perfectly watertight, and water may enter when it rains, etc.
- Do not store valuables or fragile articles in the tank bag.
- When washing the motorcycle and when leaving the motorcycle, remove the tank bag.
- Before installation, remove all dust, sand, etc. from fuel tank and tank bag, as otherwise the fuel tank may be damaged.
- Never use organic solvents such as gasoline, thinner and benzine to clean this accessory. Also do not use acid or alkaline cleaners to clean this accessory.

Wipe up spilled brake or battery fluid at once as they may damage the surface.





2. Install the tank bag as shown.

WHEEL STRIPE
