

## **USE AND CARE INFORMATION**


- Do not let anyone ride on the seat cowl and do not place luggage onto it.
- When this accessory becomes dirty, rinse it thoroughly with cool water to remove loose dirt, then wipe with a clean cloth or sponge. Do not use a brush to clean this accessory as it may scratch the surface.
- Never use petroleum solvents such as gasoline, thinner or benzine to clean this accessory. Also do not use acid or alkaline cleaners.

## **INSTALLATION**


1. Unlock the passenger seat with the ignition key and remove it as shown.



3. Clean the gray area as shown in the illustration thoroughly using isopropyl alcohol and a shop towel.




3. Attach the protective tape in the gray areas as shown.




PROTECTIVE TAPE (small)
Remove the adhesive backing before attaching.


4. Attach the rubber pads as shown.




RUBBER PAD

- 5. Install the seat cowl as shown.
  - Be sure the seat cowl is locked securely in position after installation.




After installing the seat cowl, pull out the rubber lightly as shown if it is pinched against the rider seat.



# **Clearance Adjustments**

• Check that the clearance is consistent between the passenger seat cowl and the rear cowl. If the clearance varies, adjust the mounting hook as shown below.



Remove the hook and install a washer(s) between the hook and seat cowl as necessary to achieve consistent clearance.

• Do this on either hook as necessary.
